## Data Recovery Tips



### Stop

If you suspect that the device or storage media has failed:

- Turn off the device immediately,
- Do not reboot, shake, disassemble or attempt to clean/dry the damaged media,
- Where possible, remove battery and immediately disconnect from any charging source.



### Do Not DIY

You should not attempt to perform recovery of the damaged media or you might experience:

- Unrecoverable data,
- Invalidated warranty.

### Important

- Ensure the media is protected and stored tightly in an anti-static bag with bubble wrap and foam protectors,
- Place small items such as flash media cards, USB drives and phones in an envelope before wrapping and placing in the box,
- Any necessary passcodes required to access the device should be provided by the user,
- Devices may be damaged upon reassembly or while attempting to recover your data,
- Options for repairing your device may not recover your data.
